The Church of the Sacred Heart is now accepting applications for the Phyllis Scherberger Service Scholarship to be awarded for the 2018-19 academic year. This scholarship, a \$1,000.00 grant, is endorsed and funded by the Parish Council to recognize young people in the church community who exemplify Christian values and a commitment to helping others through their service to church, school, and local communities. This program is open to students who:

- will graduate from high school in the Spring of 2018
- are members in good standing at the Church of the Sacred Heart
- are actively practicing their Catholic faith (including regular Mass attendance)
- plan to attend a two or four year college, university, or technical school
- have an exemplary record of church and community service.

To apply for the 2018 scholarship program, please complete the attached application package and return it with your **sealed** letters of recommendation to the church office, ATTN: Scholarship Committee, **NO LATER THAN 3 p.m. ON Thursday, April 26, 2018**. The applications will then be judged by a panel of volunteer graders (none of whom is a staff member, parent of an applicant, or the scholarship chair). These graders will evaluate each section of the application, with all sections weighed equally, to arrive at a composite score that determines the recipient.
